Any student who attends St. John of God Summer School does not need to show proof as we will already have a record.

→**Parents of Students entering Pre-K, Kindergarten or First Grade:** Please bring in copies of updated Immunization Records/CHDP/ Physical and/or any other forms filled out and signed by your child's physician to Registration.

→**Parents of Students entering Seventh or Eighth Grade:** Please bring in copies of the Pertussis Booster (Tdap) vaccine documentation required prior to admittance of school. There will be a station specifically set up for this paperwork.

→**Uniformity will be on site in the large hall on August 17<sup>th</sup> only, between 3:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m.**
