## All School Discipline Plan

Discipline in St. John of God is considered an aspect of moral guidance and not a form of punishment. The purpose of discipline is: to promote character training, to increase respect for duly constituted authority, to assist the growth of self-discipline, and to provide a classroom situation conducive to learning. Discipline is said to be maintained in the classroom or school when pupils work cooperatively with principal, teachers, staff members, and companions toward attainment of class and school objectives. Therefore, anyone who does not adhere to the regulations deemed necessary for a good learning situation and an orderly atmosphere is acting in a manner detrimental to the welfare of the other children. Teachers will take the means necessary and reasonable to correct the situation and will make the parents aware of a recurrent problem. (Handbook)

- 1. First Detention: Half Hour**
- 2. Second Detention: Half Hour**

- 3. Third Detention: One Hour and  
Parent/Student/Teacher/Administrator Conference and  
Disciplinary Probation #1 (Duration Usually Four Weeks)\***

- 4. Fourth Detention: One Hour and  
Disciplinary Probation #2 (Duration: Usually Four Weeks)\*  
Suspension (Duration TBA) / Recorded on transcript**
- 5. Fifth Detention: Student may be asked to withdraw! or  
Possible Expulsion!**

### \* Disciplinary Probation:

Parent/Student/Teacher/Administrator Conference  
Removal from extracurricular activities for 4 weeks (usually):  
Sports, Drama, Choir, Student Council, Special Committees, etc.
